



## Transport

### Where can I park at the University?

To park at the University, Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm, you must purchase a permit to park. This can be done by going online or contacting the parking office. Anyone using the University roads and car parks automatically agrees when entering the campus to abide by the University Traffic Regulations. These regulations are available online [www.kent.ac.uk/estates/transport](http://www.kent.ac.uk/estates/transport) or contact the parking office.

**Pink Zone car parks** are found within the centre of Canterbury Campus. This area is restricted to pink permit holders only.

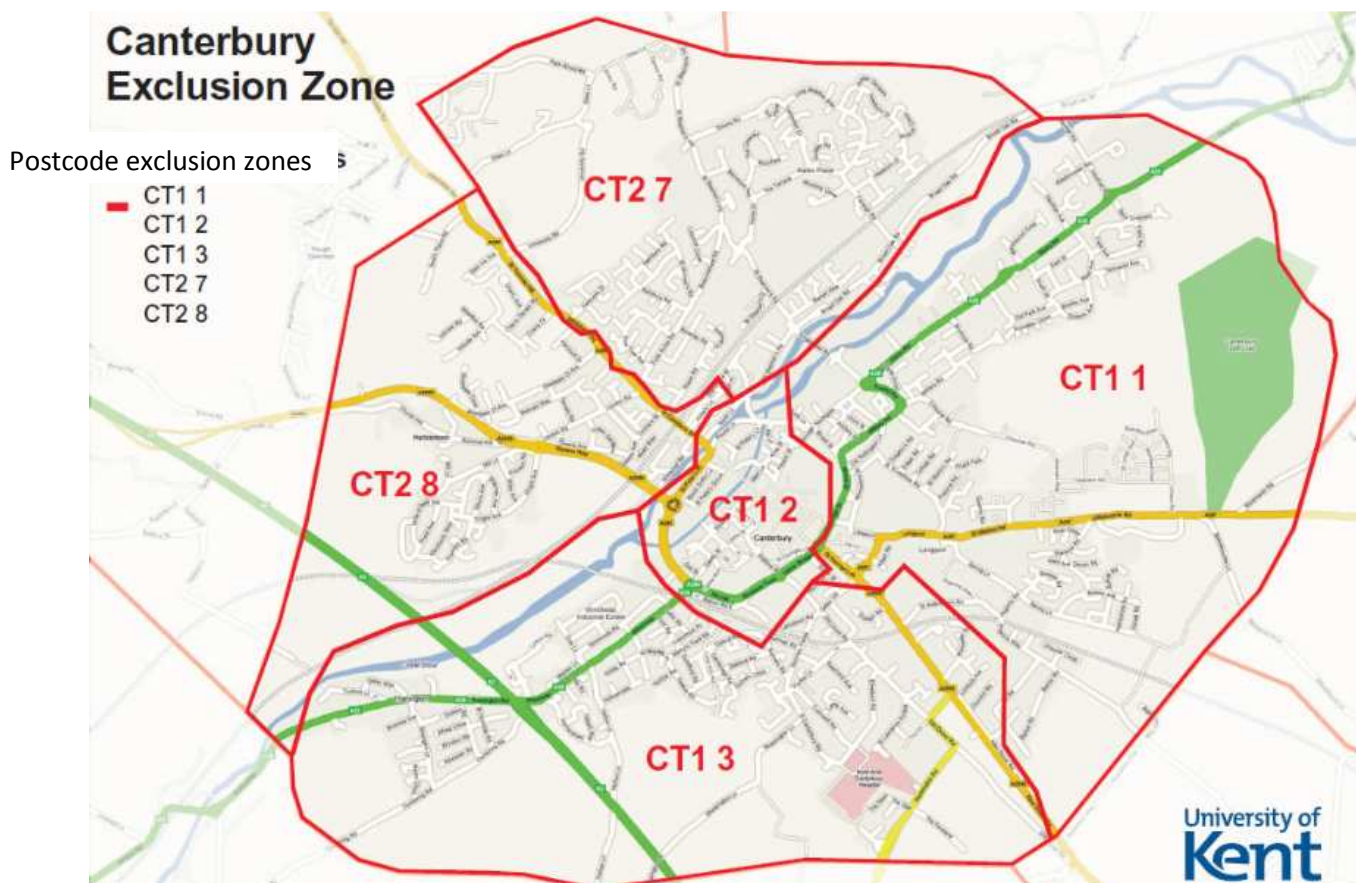
**Blue Zone car parks** are non central car parks at the Canterbury Campus. All permit holders can park in these car parks, unless the permit states otherwise.

**Accessible Bays** are available to all Government Blue Badge Holders. Staff and Students who hold a blue badge must obtain an Accessible Bay permit, free of charge. Bays are available across the campus. If there is not a bay situated in an area which you frequently use, please contact the parking office.

Please note if you are found to contravene the University of Kent's Traffic Regulations you will be given an Excess Charge Notice. For example this charge will be given to those who park in areas which are not designated parking bays.

### **Canterbury Student Exclusion Zone**

Only eligible students can obtain a permit to park. This means students who do **not** live on campus or within the Canterbury Exclusion Zone; unless they have an exceptional circumstance such as a medical reason or caring responsibilities can apply. Please go online for further information or contact the parking office. See exclusion zone map below to view if you live within the exclusion zone.



## What 'permit' to park do I need?

There are annual and temporary permits available to purchase. Please note that there may be restrictions on the type of permit you may wish to purchase.

If none of the 'permit types' below state what you require for your needs, please contact the parking office and we will endeavour to assist.

Permit Type		Charge
<b>Pink Annual Permit</b>	Available to staff only, who wish to use any car park throughout the transport year (1 October to 30 September). It is for permanent members of staff or anyone who will be working for the University for at least a year. It allows the holder to park in any car park on campus except for Giles Lane and the Sports Centre visitor Pay & Display car parks. Applications for this permit can be made online <a href="http://www.kent.ac.uk/estates/transport">www.kent.ac.uk/estates/transport</a>	Is in accordance with your salary. £1 - £25,000 = £30 £25,001 - £37,000 = £50 £37,001+ = £75
<b>Blue Annual Permit</b>	Available to all staff & eligible students who want to use a car park throughout the transport year (1 October to 30 September) but will be restricted to Blue Zone car parks only. This means you cannot park in Pink Zone car parks or Giles Lane and the Sports Centre visitor Pay & Display car parks. Applications for this permit can be made online <a href="http://www.kent.ac.uk/estates/transport">www.kent.ac.uk/estates/transport</a>	£20.00 within a transport year
<b>Temporary Permit</b>	Available to all staff & eligible students who want to use a car park for a period of time during the transport year. (1 October to 30 September). These can be issued for either Pink or Blue Zone in accordance with the Traffic Regulations. Staff paid by timesheet can apply online <a href="http://www.kent.ac.uk/estates/transport">www.kent.ac.uk/estates/transport</a> . For all other people please contact the parking office	£4 per month
<b>Occasional User Permit (OUP)</b>	Available for staff who only need to use a car park a few times within the transport year. It is ideal for those who usually commute by public transport or car share. Please see OUP guidelines for further information. These can be issued for either Pink or Blue Zone in accordance with the Traffic Regulations. Applications for this permit can be made by contacting the parking office.	50p per day
<b>Car Share (5share)</b>	Available to staff and eligible students. This permit allows a team of car sharers who are travelling together full time, to share the cost of a permit. Staff can park in all car parks, Students park in Blue Zone car parks only. Please see the car share guidelines for further information. Applications for this permit can be made by contacting the parking office. If you wish to find someone to car share with take a look at the University car share database <a href="http://www.5HARE.co.uk">www.5HARE.co.uk</a>	Staff £15.00 per person within a car share team. Students £20 per car share team.
<b>Accessible Bay Permit</b>	This permit is available to all Government Blue Badge Holders to use all bays in all car parks including the disabled bays. Applications for this permit can be made online <a href="http://www.kent.ac.uk/estates/transport">www.kent.ac.uk/estates/transport</a> or contact the parking office.	Free
