Why?

Module evaluations are an important opportunity for you (and BSIS) to reflect on your modules to date. Your feedback helps us understand what you like and what you don't like about various aspects of your modules. It also helps us make decisions about any changes we may need to make to them as a result, especially where a theme or pattern emerges from your responses and written comments.

You should be aware that BSIS highly values your feedback and your opinions matter to us. The more considered feedback we receive, the better we are able to reflect and respond to it. We would therefore appreciate you taking a few minutes to complete a survey for each module you are studying.

The results of these are viewed by both the Module convenor and the Director of Graduate Studies.

Each module convenor compiles an Annual Module Report which is submitted to the Departmental Director of Learning and Teaching.

When?

The survey will run at the end of term 1. For modules that continue and/or start in the spring term you will have the opportunity to evaluate these in March next year.

How?

The module evaluations are carried out entirely online and your responses are completely anonymous to BSIS. Once the surveys are released you will receive an email to notify you that you have a survey to complete.
