# Note: It is ultimately your responsibility to ensure that you are registered for the correct modules for your course.

You must study 120 Credits at both Stage 2 and Stage 3 giving a total of 240 Credits over the two stages. At least 90 Credits must be taken at Level 6 during Stage 3 to be eligible for an Honours degree. You must ensure that you choose an even weighting of Credits in each term: 60 Credits in the Autumn and 60 Credits in the Spring.

If a module is available at both Levels 5 and 6, then Stage 2 students should take the Level 5 and Stage 3 the Level 6. Students cannot take both versions of the same module.

#### YEAR ABROAD – STAGE A

If you are taking a SCL course with a Year Abroad, please see the relevant three year course section for your Stage 2 or 3 module options. The Year Abroad is taken between stages 2 and 3.

During your year abroad, you will follow a course of full-time study at one of our approved overseas Universities. Students will select courses before going abroad in consultation with the School.

#### **TERM ABROAD – STAGE 2 OR 3**

- Please note: Joint honours students taking the term abroad will **not** be permitted to take elective modules in order to ensure they reach the minimum 90 credits per subject requirement.
