Note: It is ultimately your responsibility to ensure that you are registered for the correct modules for your course.

You must study 120 credits at both Stage 2 and Stage 3 giving a total of 240 credits over the two stages. At least 90 credits must be taken at Level 6 during Stage 3 to be eligible for an Honours degree. You must ensure that you choose an even weighting of credits in each term: 60 credits in the Autumn and 60 credits in the Spring. **No Level 4 modules can be taken at Stage 3.**

Taking a Year Abroad

The School of Social Policy, Sociology and Social Research offers their undergraduate students the chance to add an optional year abroad to their course of study. Please see the Study Abroad pages at <https://www.kent.ac.uk/go-abroad/study-abroad/course-list> for available courses. General information on study abroad options is available at <https://www.kent.ac.uk/go-abroad>.

To be eligible for study abroad, you would normally need to have achieved an average of 60 or above in your first and second year of study. You are also advised to attend key talks and workshops offered by the International Partnerships Office and the School.

Where required, language achievement will be expected to be 40% or above as the courses the module contributes to are not language courses. To attend an institution where the language of instruction is not English, students must be able to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Year Abroad module Convenor that they have sufficient language ability to do so, acquired either through modules studied at Kent or through other study or experience. This will include demonstrating the ability to communicate orally and in writing up to a level commensurate with degree level study. Students will also be required to enter into a Learning Agreement negotiated with the Director of Studies for the courses or the SSPSSR Director of International Courses and the Convenor of the Year Abroad Module.

Year Abroad – STAGE A – 120 credits

Students take 120 credits at Stage A which are the compulsory modules. Students are free to spend their year abroad at any of the institutions with which the University has a current Memorandum of Association, but will be advised by the SSPSSR Director of International Courses and the Convenor of the Year Abroad Module (usually the same person). The curriculum will be dependent on the student's selection of modules at the host institution. Students will undertake study as directed by course directors and module Convenors in the institutions where they are enrolled and be assessed accordingly. In addition, students will retain contact with staff at Kent whilst abroad.
