**Stages 2 and 3: Subject requirements are for students entering the specified stage in the 2026-27 academic year only.**

**Note: It is ultimately your responsibility to ensure that you are registered for the correct modules for your course.**

You must study 120 Credits in both Stage 2 and in Stage 3 (giving a total of 240 Credits over the two Stages); and if appropriate, 120 Credits over Stage 4 (giving a total of 360 Credits over three Stages of a four year course). To be eligible for an Honours degree, at least 90 Credits must be taken at Level 6 in the final Stage – i.e. Stage 3 or 4 as appropriate. You must ensure that you choose an even weighting of Credits in each term: 40 Credits in the Autumn / 40 Credits in the Spring and 40 Credits in the Summer.

## Qualification as a Solicitor or Barrister in England and Wales

**All of the undergraduate law degrees offered by Kent Law School will be recognised as Qualifying Law Degrees ('QLD(s)') for the purposes of qualification as a solicitor or barrister for students who start(ed) their courses before:**

- September 2022 (for prospective solicitors) i.e. started no later than 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021; and
- September 2019 (for prospective barristers).

**As of 2019 entry, the Bar Standards Board have ceased their recognition of any undergraduate law degree (at Kent, and elsewhere) as a QLD. HOWEVER, in order to continue to satisfy the academic component of professional training for intending barristers, all students must study the 'Foundations of Legal Knowledge' (modules that all KLS undergraduate law degrees offer); and they must adhere to the requirements specified below.**

**Students who successfully obtain a QLD are exempt from the need to undertake a conversion course (i.e. the Common Professional Examination) and can proceed directly to the Legal Practice Course (for solicitors) or the Bar Professional Training Course (for barristers). Progression to the vocational component of training for barristers (currently in the form of the BPTC) will remain, as now, subject to successfully completing the Foundations of Legal knowledge and obtaining an overall degree classification of at least 2:2.**

More detailed information about qualification as a solicitor or barrister, QLDs, and the changes to professional qualification, can be found on the relevant profession's website.

**The seven Foundations of Legal Knowledge (FLK) listed by the Bar Standards Board in the present [Qualification Manual](#) are as follows:**

- Criminal Law;
- Equity and Trusts;
- Law of the European Union;
- Obligations 1 (Contract);
- Obligations 2 (Tort);
- Property/Land Law; and

- Public Law (Constitutional Law, Administrative Law and Human Rights Law).

**Students must take and pass (i.e. attain a mark of at least 40% in) the modules containing the Foundations of Legal Knowledge as offered by Kent (listed below) over the course of their degree. The first set are the modules offered as part of the Foundations of Legal Knowledge prior to September 2025. For students who started before September 2025, you will be taking a combination of these modules that you have already undertaken and the new Foundations of Legal Knowledge modules commencing in September 2025, to ensure full coverage of the Foundations of Legal Knowledge.**

These modules serve as the Foundations of Legal Knowledge for the purposes of qualification as a barrister and are required in order to obtain a QLD. To obtain a Qualifying Law Degree (QLD), in addition to the exemption modules, students must also successfully complete a further 60 credits of Law. The QLD is no longer required for continuation to Solicitors' Qualifying Exams (SQE), the route to becoming a solicitor, however it is highly recommended that the Foundations of Legal Knowledge are studied as this knowledge forms the foundation for the SQE.

## **Implications of failing the Foundations of Legal Knowledge (FLK) modules**

It is vital that students **PASS ALL** the FLK modules listed above; there may be serious consequences for failing to do so. Where a student fails one or more exemption modules, the University's rules governing compensation<sup>1</sup> and condonement<sup>2</sup> might nevertheless permit the student to progress to the next Stage of their degree, or even pass their degree as a whole.

However, the FLK's will still have been failed. As a result, the student will not have passed the Foundations of Legal Knowledge and, where applicable, will not obtain a QLD/satisfy the Foundations of Legal Knowledge.

The Bar Standards Board (BSB) grants the Board of Examiners the discretion to compensate a single failure of an exemption module, but only in exceptional circumstances and if specific criteria are met. <sup>1</sup> 'Compensation' is where credit is awarded for a module that has been narrowly failed (i.e. a module mark of 30-39% has been achieved).

<sup>2</sup> 'Condonement' is where credit is awarded for a failed module because of documented illness, or other mitigating circumstances (irrespective of the mark achieved).

### **Number of attempts**

The Bar Standards Board (BSB) s allow a maximum of three attempts at each exemption module (one initial attempt followed by two further attempts). Attempts treated 'as for the first time' do not count for this purpose. If a student is compensated or condoned **before being given three attempts** to allow them to progress or graduate, the student may be able to sit the module again alongside their course of study.

### **Time limits**

All students, regardless of whether they are full or part-time, have **six years** to complete their law degree for the purposes of qualifying as a barrister.

**Note:** Discretion is afforded to the Board of Examiners to extend this time limit, but only in exceptional circumstances. Students are advised to contact the Student Engagement Support Office: [engagementsupport@kent.ac.uk](mailto:engagementsupport@kent.ac.uk) for further guidance.

### **Conversion course**

Students who have not passed all of the exemption modules, or have otherwise failed to obtain a QLD, may be able to complete their academic training by undertaking a conversion course, the Graduate Diploma in Law (GDL), at another institution. The University of Kent does not offer this course. Students in this situation should consult the Director of Studies.

### **Qualification as a lawyer in other jurisdictions**

**STAGE 2**

**Single Honours**

International Legal Studies is a four-year course, offered in cooperation with partners in Hong Kong, Japan, Canada and Australia (tbc). Students from the University of Kent registering for this degree will spend the first two years and the final year (Stages 1, 2 and 3) of the degree course at Kent and the third year (Stage A) at their partner institution.

Students choosing to go to the partner institutions in Hong Kong and Japan are encouraged to study Mandarin, Chinese or Japanese classes.

In order to progress to the year abroad, students must achieve an average of 50% in Stage 1 and 50% in Stage 2 (and any other requirements that our international partner institutions may demand, including a higher requirement than 50%). The Director of Studies for the course will consider applications for entry to the year abroad from students who do not achieve the required average if:

- a) there is documented evidence of exceptional circumstances which have interfered with the student's academic performance in Stage 1, and
- b) The Director of the course is satisfied that, where appropriate to the circumstances, appropriate support is available whilst abroad to mitigate the effect of those circumstances, or
- c) in order to contribute to widening participation in Higher Education, the student meets one or more of the contextual indicators required for entry.

Students should be aware that due to the entry requirements prescribed by some of our partner institutions, for example Osgoode Hall and Hong Kong University, a year abroad at these institutions will not be possible without an average of 60% in Stage 1 and 2.

Students who are not eligible for the year abroad can transfer to another course; normally the Single Honours LLB Law.
