Students successfully passing this course may then progress to any one of the following programmes:

- MSc Economics
- MSc Economics and Econometrics
- MSc Development Economics
- MSc Financial Economics
- MSc International Finance and Economics
- MSc Quantitative Finance and Econometrics

Students successfully completing Stage 1 of the programme and meeting credit framework requirements who do not wish to continue to Stage 2, or who do not successfully complete Stage 2, will be eligible for the award of the Diploma in Economic Analysis (PDip).
