JOINT HONOURS LAW STUDENTS

Students undertaking a Joint Honours Law degree who take and pass the above modules (and in the case of aspiring Barristers obtain a 2:2 (Hons) degree overall) will be able to obtain a qualifying Law degree which will exempt them from the Common Professional Examination and enable them to proceed to the Legal Practice Course or the Bar Vocational Course. Subject to the exceptions below, students who wish to be exempted must take in Stage 1 LW313 *A Critical Introduction to Law*, LW304 *Obligations I* and **either** LW508 *Criminal Law* **or** LW588 *Public Law 1*.

EXCEPTIONS:

Law and Accounting & Finance and **Psychology and Law** students are unable to comply with the above rubric. Law and Accounting & Finance students take LW502 *Business Law* in Stage 1 and Psychology and Law students take LW313 *A Critical Introduction to Law*. However, because these are 4-year degree programmes, students are able to take all the required modules (listed above) during the course of their programmes.

Law and Economics and IRHRM (Law) Joint Honours students are unable to take all of the above modules and should therefore consult the Director of Studies as to the route to Professional qualification.

Students who have not passed all seven 'core' modules may nonetheless be able to obtain professional qualification in due course by fulfilling the requirements of the legal professions' Common Professional Examination.
