BARRISTERS

You must take and pass the exemption modules listed above and obtain an overall 2:2 (Hons.) degree in order to obtain exemption from the Common Professional Examination and be eligible to proceed to the Bar Vocational Course.

Implication of failure in exemption modules

It is vital that you **PASS ALL** your exemption modules: these are listed above. There are serious consequences for not achieving 40% in such a module. While the University compensation rules may permit you to progress to the next Stage, or even to pass your degree as a whole, you will still have failed an exemption module. This means that you will NOT have obtained a Qualifying Law Degree. In turn, this means that your name will not appear on the group certificate provided by the Law School to the Joint Academic Standards Board.

Number of attempts

The SRA will allow a maximum of three attempts at the exemption modules which include any attempts that are "as for the first time". If you have had three attempts and are then compensated, you will need to consult the relevant professional bodies for advice.

If you have been compensated before having three attempts and are still within your programme of study at the University, you may sit the module for exemption purposes only. However, this will not count towards your final degree classification.

If you have been compensated before having three attempts and then graduate, you may take up the offer of sitting as an external candidate at the first available opportunity at Kent. For example, if you graduate with a compensated mark in an exemption module in July 2011, the first available opportunity to sit for exemption purposes will be in August 2011.

Time limits for qualifying Law degrees

JOINT HONOURS LAW STUDENTS

Students undertaking a Joint Honours Law degree who take and pass the above modules (and in the case of aspiring Barristers obtain a 2:2 (Hons) degree overall) will be able to obtain a Qualifying Law Degree which will exempt them from the Common Professional Examination and enable them to proceed to the Legal Practice Course or the Bar Vocational Course.

Students who have not taken all exemption modules may nonetheless be able to obtain professional qualification in due course by fulfilling the requirements of the legal professions' Common Professional Examination.
