## SOCIOLOGY WITH A YEAR IN FINLAND

The degree in Sociology with a year in Finland is a four-year programme offered in co-operation with the University of Tampere. Students from the University of Kent registered for this degree will spend Stage 1, 2 and 3 of the degree at Kent and the third year (Stage A) at Tampere. While at Kent, students will follow modules from the programme for the BA in Sociology. While in Finland, students will follow an approved programme drawn from the modules offered by the University of Tampere International School of Social Sciences. These modules are taught and assessed in English.

Students take modules totalling **240 Credits** at the University of Kent, 120 Credits at each Stage, of which at least **90 Credits** must be taken at Level H. Students will be required to undertake modules amounting to 120 Credits

(equivalent to 60 ECTS) during their year abroad, leading to a total of **360 Credits** for Stages 2, A and 3. Further details may be obtained from the Director of Studies.

Students from the University of Kent registered for this degree will spend Stage 1, 2 and 3 of the degree at Kent. They will spend the third year (Stage A) at Barcelona. While at Kent, students will follow modules from the programme for the BA in Sociology. While in Spain, students will follow an approved programme drawn from the modules offered by the Autonomous University of Barcelona. Although some of the modules will be taught in Catalan, Erasmus students can choose from a wide variety of courses taught in Spanish.

Students take modules totalling **240 Credits** at the University of Kent, 120 Credits at each Stage, of which at least **90 Credits** must be taken at Level H. Students will be required to undertake modules amounting to 120 Credits (equivalent to 60 ECTS) during their year abroad, leading to a total of **360 Credits** for Stages 2, A and 3.
