**As a student you are expected to attend all teaching activity and fully engage with your studies.**

**If you are not able to attend teaching, we are here to help. If you start missing a lot of teaching activity, the following intervention procedure will apply.**

The escalation steps outlined in this diagram apply to all undergraduate and postgraduate taught students with low in-person attendance (10% or less) at timetabled teaching activities, with the following exceptions:

Excluding Apprenticeship students, Distance Learners, and students on Placements.

Excluding students on Support to Study or Fitness to Practice.

Excluding students with course-specific attendance requirements (in which case the escalation steps will apply, but the course-specific attendance requirement will be applied).

Excluding students for whom sponsorship agreements supersede the University Attendance and Engagement policy.

Students not included in the Student Attendance and Engagement procedure will be monitored following different procedures as appropriate.

**Students can end the escalation procedure at any point by re-engaging with their studies. Students who fully engage with their studies will not be escalated.**
