TO STOP FRAUD™

Courier Fraud

If you get a call from your Bank or Police saying they need your card and PIN number as evidence for an investigation and they will send a courier to collect it, don't as it is a SCAM. Your Bank or the Police will never do this and neither will they ask you your PIN number.

If you think that you may have been a victim of this type of scam, then contact your Bank immediately and report it to Action Fraud at www.actionfraud.police.uk or calling 0300 123 2040.

Or if you have had a call like this and are still waiting for someone to collect your card, then contact Police immediately on 101 or if an emergency on 999.
