BT Phishing Scam

Another phishing email to look out for, this time BT. Action Fraud have received numerous reports of these emails, which state your bill is ready to pay and requests you click on a link. This will take you to a genuine looking website, where not only will it steal your personal and financial information but also your BT log in details.

If you are unsure always contact the organisation directly using a trusted number but not one provided in their email.

BT SCAM EMAILS

Action Fraud has received 676 reports in two weeks relating to fake emails purporting to be from BT. The emails commonly use the subject line "Your bill is ready" and provide a link that can be used to make a payment. The links in the emails lead to genuine-looking phishing websites that are designed to steal BT login credentials, as well as personal and financial information.

If you have doubts about a message, contact the organisation directly. **Don't** use the numbers or address in the message - use the details from their official website. Your bank (or any other official source) will never ask you to supply personal information via email.
