Kent's international links provide a range of opportunities for postgraduates to study or research abroad. International experiences can enhance academic, personal and professional development.

Jointly supervised PhDs (cotutelles)

Jointly supervised PhDs (commonly known as cotutelles) offer PhD students the chance to be jointly supervised by the University of Kent and a university in another country. This results in a dual, or sometimes a joint, award of a PhD from Kent and a doctorate from the partner university.

Kent has existing cotutelle partnerships with a range of institutions including:

- University of Cologne, Germany
- University of Ghent, Belgium
- University of Lausanne, Switzerland
- University of Technology, Sydney, Australia
