Štefan Füle started his professional career at the Czechoslovakian Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1987 and since then has held many important positions at the Ministry, Czech embassies abroad as well as international organizations such as UN or NATO. Between 2005-9 he served as Czech Permanent Representative to NATO, after which he was appointed European Affairs Minister. Štefan Füle served as European Commissioner for Enlargement and Neighbourhood Policy between 2010 and 2014. Štefan Füle recently joined the International Advisory Board of the Central European Strategy Council and he is also a member of the Advisory Board of Friends of Europe.
